<p>The checkbox form element intentionally renders an additional hidden input element with the same name. This leads to issues in the frontend where input elements are selected by name. see <a href="#">#11750</a></p> <p>The reason for the double input element is a workaround produced by Carsten in the PHP function <code>AbstractBuildForm-&gt;buildCheckbox</code> It would be best if the hidden input element had a different unique name.</p>
