Advanced:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• QFQ implements its own documentation page which also supports the tag feature explained above.• On the QFQ documentation page we could also render the sql table and column comments.• When hovering over a dokumentation-tag-link (e.g. inside form editor) then a preview of the respective documentation text is shown.	
BPMN:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• On the qfq documentation page a BPMN editor is integrated.• Documentation tags may also be used inside a BPMN bubble which is then automatically linked to the respective documentaiton
